President's Report

As Interim President of Ballarat Gold Swimming Club, it is with great pride that I present our report for the 2023/2024 season. This year has been a remarkable journey for our club, filled with notable achievements, community engagement, and significant growth. At the 2024 Swimming Victoria Awards we were thrilled to be awarded a Top 10 Club Award for the second year in a row, this year coming 7th.

Celebrating Our Events and Competitions

One of the standout highlights of our season was our participation in the Australian Age Championships on the Gold Coast. We had a team of 17 swimmers compete at Nationals. Their performance was exemplary, with three swimmers achieving top 10 placings. At the Australian Open Championships Sarah Howe and Anna Leighton both competed in multiple finals. These accomplishments are a testament to the hard work and dedication of our swimmers and coaches. Our competitive swimmers continued to excel throughout the year. The short course season saw fantastic camaraderie and achievements. Short Course Countries saw 38 swimmers travel to Wangaratta where we came home with 27 individual medals. Twenty swimmers went to MSAC to compete at State Age SC Championships where 13 individual medals were won, at Opens 14 swimmers competed and 16 individual medals were won. Long course season was equally impressive, with our swimmers making significant strides at major meets and our most successful long course season to date. The first championship event was Vic Age. Here 19 swimmers competed and 12 individual medals were won, it would be remiss to not mention the success of Sarah Howe at this meet, who won a staggering 9 individual medals – 8 Gold and 1 silver – amazing! Open Long Course saw 18 swimmers compete and 7 medals won. Long Course Countries in Traralgon was another successful meet for our club and swimmers. We had for the first time two of our swimmers compete in the Australian Open Water Championships – Tom Urquhart and Marley Sutherland travelled to Busselton, both swimming the 5000m free and placing 9th and 15th respectively – such a fabulous achievement. All topped off by Sarah Howe and Ed Meddings competing at Olympic Trials – WOW!

Congratulations to our swimmers - we are immensely proud of the Gold spirit and the wonderful results.

Community Engagement and Development

This year, we focused on enhancing our community presence and engagement. Our participation in The Ballarat Foundation's Run for a Cause, Laps for Lachie and the introduction of the scholarships program are highlights. Our involvement in these events not only raised significant funds but also showcased our club's dedication to making a positive impact in the community.



Ballarat Gold Swimming Club was first started in 1998 by Peter Pay. Since this time the Club has steadily grown and prospered due to the hard work of the Committee and the Coaching staff.

With the introduction of a new sponsor in 2014 and the growth of the club, the committee was compelled to review the club awards resulting in changes to the awards and their age criteria. 
